



# Reward for Greenland halibut tags

The Institute of Marine Research (IMR) has tagged Greenland halibuts to be able to study the age by using otoliths and bone-structures. If you get a tagged Greenland halibut in your catch, we would like to have both the fish and the tag, together with the date and the position where the fish was caught.

If the fish with tag on (intact, not headless) together with catchinformation is sent to us, the fisherman will receive a reward of NOK 1000,- and a T-shirt (remember to specify the correct size). If only the tag is sent to us, the fish is headless or the catchinformation is not available, the fisherman is rewarded with a T-shirt.
